




## Figure No. 2 marks the spot.

Named an Interior Design Best of Year award winner in 2014, Figure No. 2 is a curvaceous pattern reminiscent of a whale's tail. This tile-based wallcovering system uses positive and negative versions of sinuous lines to create graphic, organic patterns and tactile dimension. The composite cork-backed tiles are covered in varied thicknesses of felt to create depth and shadow. Choose one color to keep the patterning subtle or play up the dimensionality with up to four colors per wall.

Figure No. 2 was designed by Submaterial, a design studio and manufacturer based in Albuquerque, New Mexico.











**Exploded Axonometric** Two Distinct Tiles in Standard Pattern

Installation	Each order includes four distinct tiles that install according to one standard pattern and attach to a wall surface using a heavy-duty wallcovering adhesive. Tiles may be trimmed to size with a utility knife. Refer to installation instructions for complete guidance.
Maintenance	Vacuum occasionally to remove general air-borne debris. Should soiling occur, spot clean with mild soap and lukewarm water. Avoid aggressive rubbing as this can continue the felting process and change the surface appearance of the felt. Refer to 100% Wool Design Felt Maintenance + Cleaning for detailed care instructions.
Variation	Wool felt is a natural material and color variation and inclusions of natural fiber on the surface are evidence of the 100% natural origin of the material. Product color is only indicative, as it is not possible to assure consistency of color in a natural product due to the natural color of raw wool and absorption of dyes. Color matching cannot be guaranteed on shipments and variation will be more pronounced beyond the normal commercial range.
