
Index Dimensional

Acoustic Wall Tile





Index Dimensional has a leg up on sound absorption. Index Dimensional captures light and shadow in a pattern of repeated and staggered rectangles. Combining one-hundred percent wool felt with natural cork composite backing—two materials known for their acoustic properties—this tile-based wallcovering system provides a dynamic effect on the wall. Choose one color to keep the patterning subtle or play up the dimensionality with up to four colors per wall.

Index Dimensional was designed by Submaterial, a design studio and manufacturer based in Albuquerque, New Mexico.
















Exploded Axonometric Standard Tile Size Shown






Standard Tile Pattern





Installation	Each order includes four distinct tiles that install in a randomized pattern and attach to a wall surface using a heavy-duty wallcovering adhesive. Tiles may be trimmed to size with a utility knife. Refer to Index Dimensional Installation Instructions for complete guidance.					
Maintenance	Vacuum occasionally to remove general air-borne debris. Should soiling occur, spot clean with mild soap and lukewarm water. Avoid aggressive rubbing as this can continue the felting process and change the surface appearance of the felt. Refer to Product Maintenance + Cleaning for detailed care instructions.					
Variation	Wool felt is a natural material and color variation and inclusions of natural fiber on the surface are evidence of the 100% natural origin of the material. Product color is only indicative, as it is not possible to assure consistency of color in a natural product due to the natural color of raw wool and absorption of dyes. Color matching cannot be guaranteed between individual tiles and expect color variation beyond the normal commercial range.
