To attract employees back into the office, the team at HOK cleverly designed the offices at Boston Consulting Group with a post-COVID workspace in mind. The architects behind the project worked to design an interior that encourages productivity but also includes a range of amenities that help support employees throughout the day.

Collaboration and inclusivity were vital in designing the innovative workspace, so the team incorporated open offices, collaborative conference rooms, convertible private offices, soundproof phone booths, a quiet library, and private nooks to work in when employees need quiet, focused areas to concentrate. Two of the unique spaces designed by HOK include installations of Duet in a calming shade of grey. Duet's on-edge detailing provides playful pops of graphic patterning while helping to keep the sound down in an office of over 400 people.
